The EMLG/JMLG annual meeting 2009 is aimed to present the most recent progress in experiment, theory and simulation of molecular liquid systems in order to understand the liquid structure resulting from intermolecular interactions between the constituents of the system in all achievable thermodynamic states, including supercritical conditions.

The European Molecular Liquids Group EMLG and the Japanese Molecular Liquids Group JMLG are interdisciplinary groups covering the molecular aspects of fluids in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. The European group was founded in 1982 and was joined by the Japanese group in 1996.
